Science Olympiad is open to the students of classes II to VIII.

The time duration of the paper will be 60 minutes. The Science Olympiad, a test of competence and knowledge in the subject of English Language, is held annually at National level, based on the syllabus prescribed by CBSE/ICSE and various other State Boards.

1. Questions of Olympiad exams will be 60% from the current class syllabus and 40% from the previous class syllabus, e.g. Class-7 exam will have 60% questions from class-7 syllabus and 40% questions from class 6 syllabus.
